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DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1: HOIAN-HUE 1DAY TRIP

Pick up at your hotel in Hoian or Danang city and Drive for Hue, some 120 km away to the north. On arrival Hue, start our sightseeing including of The charming Lady Pagoda (Thien Mu Pagoda) will be the first stop of the day. You will enjoy a great view on the Perfume River and surrounding area. Thien Mu Pagoda is considered the symbol of Hue, and of Buddhism in Vietnam. Next to visit the tomb of king Minh Mang and king Tu Duc, Hue Citadel and Dong Ba market. tour ends, drive back to Hoi and drop off at hotel (No later at 05.30 PM).

NOTE

With an area of 500ha and a system of three circles of ramparts, namely from outside to inside: Kinh Thanh Hue (Hue Capital Citadel), Hoang Thanh (Royal Citadel) and Tu Cam Thanh (Forbidden Citadel). Hue has chosen to be the capital city of the Southern Kingdom by all Lords Nguyen and officially became the capital under Tay Son Dynasty. For approximately 400 years, Hue has become a great landscape and architectural site. Hue royal complex has been officially recognized by the UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.
